精彩书评

1、第一次读除经典名著外的英文小说(可能自己孤陋寡闻,认为它不是经典),看的这版封面是白 色的,也就手掌那么大,很轻,适合外出放在包里随时拿出来读。断断续续,用了两三个星期吧。读 完最大的感受是,文字很美,叙述很吸引人,意义值得回味。小说的叙述方式比较独特,插叙加倒叙 。从主人公Eddie因事故死去的那一刻开始,通过在天堂里陆续遇到的五个人,讲述Eddie人生的重要 片段;同时用" Today is Eddie's Birthday "贯穿了Eddie的整个人生经历,从几岁到八十几岁,讲到了他 的家庭、成长、工作、情感。由于这种穿插叙述,只有当我看到后面甚至整本书,才明白小说的结构 和作者的思路,并对Eddie的人生有了比较完整清晰的了解。越到后面越好看,一有空就想继续读。当 然,优美的文字也是我越来越喜欢读这个故事的原因。对于Eddie的情绪变化,心理波折等等的描画, 让人身临其境。这本书也让我第一次感受到优美语言的相通性,原来英语刻画起细节来,很多抓到的 画面和用词甚至与汉语如出一辙,这让阅读更加增添了体味文字魅力的乐趣。对于书中的这个故事, 我挺好奇:为什么作者有这样的一个构思,为什么他想写这样的一个故事。天堂里遇见的五个人,不 论是他的人生被自己不经意间改变,亦或是他改变了自己的人生,或是自己生命中的最重要,再或是 自己一生中情感锁链的旁观和解答者,还是被自己错过的一个小生命,每一个故事,都令人恍然大悟 或惊讶万分,这些故事环环相扣,最终又转回到原点。原来,人活着时,有这么多并不知晓的人和事 与自己发生直接间接的联系,有些甚至影响到我们的人生轨迹和生命。原来,一切解答以后,我们还 是会跟自己最重要的那个人在一起。不管这天堂里的故事是否会发生,它让我莫名的对自己的人生也 开始坦然,自己有时纠结的不能释怀的经历和观点,再想想竟然觉得释然了。是相信宿命了吗?还是 相信这些纠结在死后都能得到答案和解脱?我不知道。引用下小说的最后一句话来结束评论: " the secrets of Heaven...that each affects the other and the other affects the next, and the world is full of stories, but the stories are all one. "
